NOVEMBER MEETING

Our demo artist was **Murray Wagnon**. Keep the spontaneity alive", stated **Murray Wagnon** when he began his CCAA demo at our November meeting. Murray demonstrated how to translate a plein air painting to a larger work back at the studio.

Beginning with graphite drawing which he then encapsulates and reduces with a wash of mineral spirits. You have solved many of the problems during your plein air session, so you are more readily aware of the next steps to take in the studio enlargement. Murray tones his canvas with a mid tone cerulean and permanent rose. The camera is a great reference tool for checking your color and composition.
